# Meeting Minutes - October 24th, 2024

### **Annie Gale School Council Meeting**

- 1. Chair's opening remarks and introductions
  Rumina started the meeting, discussed briefly about the meeting agenda
- 2. Review of minutes from last meeting Rumina raised the last meeting minutes. Laurel agreed and Kal seconded

## 3. Principal's Report

- Soccer season over: boys and girls' teams both won the championship
- Wrestling is starting and we will have approximately 40 students participating
- Basketball tournament in November has been cancelled as we did not have enough schools ask to be involved. The basketball season is running smoothly though we are limiting the number of fans in the gym and using attendance and good behavior as incentives to attend.
- Fall break is coming up: it starts with a System Non-instructional Day on November 8 which will focus on Indigenous Learning for all CBE employees. The break for students is from November 8 to November 13. School is back in on Thursday, November 14.
- First circle session with Grade 6 classes—Principal and two teachers role
  played for students and asked them to problem solve responses to bullying of
  a student. We stressed the differences between nice kid, mean kid, and wise
  child. We encouraged them to be wise and when their wisdom working with
  others isn't effective, to ask for adult support.
- Visit from Wali Shah, poet, author and speaker. Students connected to him and enjoyed their time. We want to see how it plays out when it comes to increasing the amount of writing students are doing.
- Awards for PE students of the month were shared with the school last Friday during Grizzly Den time. PE teachers use the COURAGE model to reinforce

- the characteristics of the model by noting those traits in students. The goal is not to focus on athletic ability but instead character traits.
- Currently looking at our data sets to create School Information Results Report, which will comment on last year's School Development Plan. The data includes PAT results from May and June as well as survey results from last year and our most recent survey. We just received our survey results yesterday, so we haven't had much time to look at the data yet. However, the anecdotal comments from students often relate to things we cannot change: TLC students want to wear regular clothes, students want to have a longer wellness break. They do, however, appreciate athletics, kind and fun teachers, kind and fun peers, option classes, homeroom class. Safety appears to be a concern, though we struggle with the accuracy of that concern. For instance, the Grade 6 students appear to be settled, happy and working well with each other. The data suggests that they don't feel safe—I plan on working with them on whether that is accurate. We are upset about the bear spray incident and believe that it negatively affected our data when it comes to school safety.
- Plan is to create a student well-being committee with input from interested students. A well-being symposium is already in the works and we hope to see that play out at school, as a small group of students will be invited to attend.
   We also plan to have some meetings of a Principal Advisory Council, to continue the dialogue that was started last year.
- There was a discussion of babysitting for school council meeting but not feasible at this time.
